Greetings

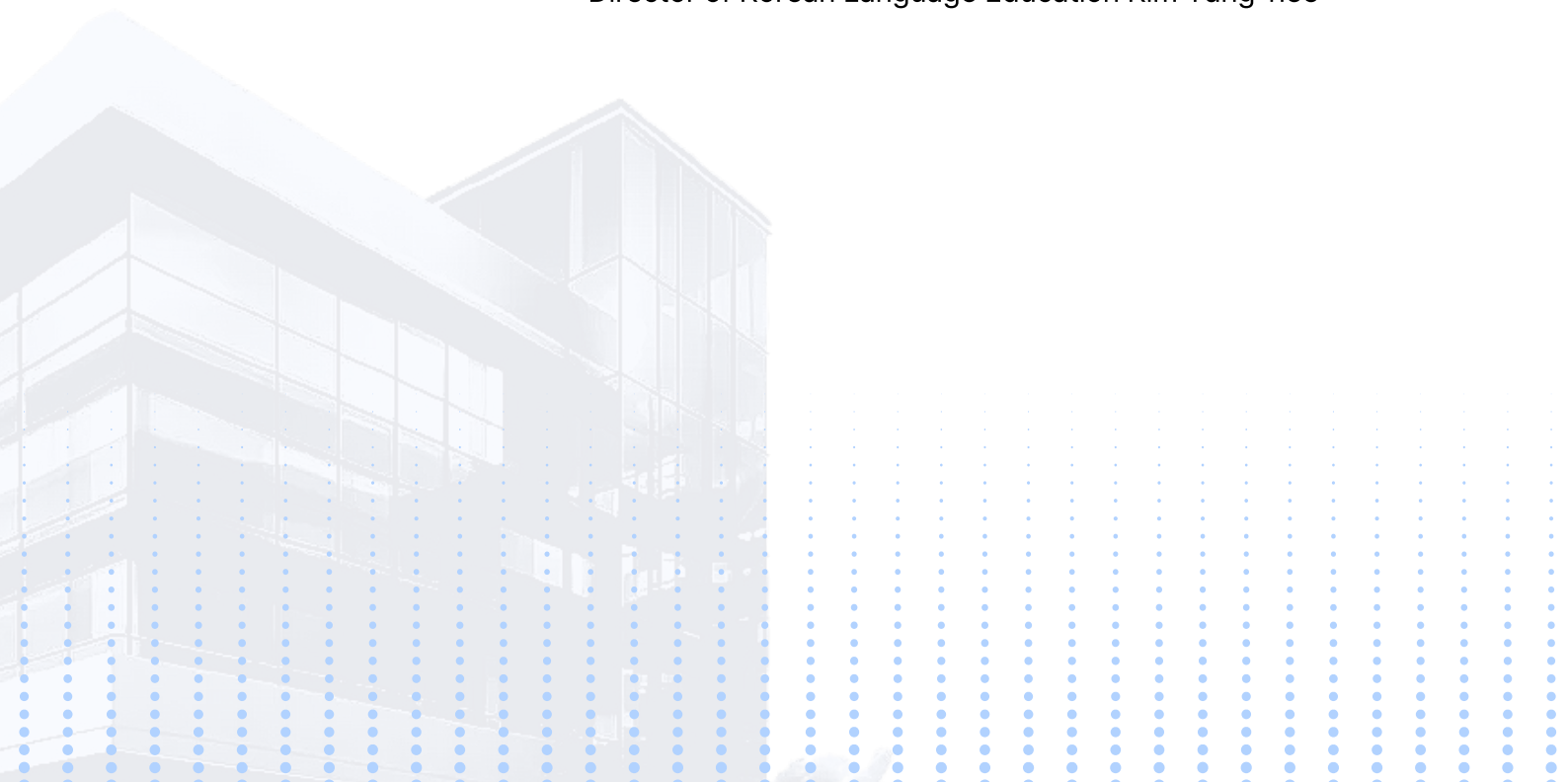
Catholic Sangji University, where 50 years of history and tradition have lived and continued with love, sincerity, and service spirit. We will open a new history of Korean language education for foreigners.

EDUCATION CONTENT

Four semesters a year (spring semester, summer semester, fall semester, winter semester), four hours a day for five days a week, and Korean culture experience activities for each semester.

EDUCATION CONTENT BY STEP

Beginner (Level 1/2)	TOPIK level 1 to level 2 Basic Korean Grammar and Sentences. Develop basic communication skills Necessary for daily life.
Intermediate (Level 3/4)	TOPIK level 3 to 4 Cultivate personal and specific expression skills in everyday life. Cultivate the ability to communicate or express one's opinion. Understanding Korean Society, Korean Culture.
Advanced (Level 5/6)	TOPIK level 5 to 6 Improving language skills to the level where you can do your job in a specialized field. Improving communication skills on various topics on Korean Society as a whole.

REGARDING APPLICATION

ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION

- Application for admission: Contact before the application (klearn@csj.ac.kr)
- Preparatory documents vary from country to country, so you must contact in advance.
- If the contents stated in the application form are false, the admission shall be canceled.
- Individual acceptance notice after document review

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

- The grades are calculated by adding up the midterm, final exam, attendance, and assignments. A report card is issued every semester.
- You need to get an average of 70 points or more for promotion.
- If the attendance rate is less than 80%, you cannot complete the course, and if you are late 3 times, you will be treated as an absence.
- However, if you are absent due to special circumstances, we will refer to it when promoting if you submit a reason in advance.
